Action Plans

Formation of a Spanish programme (in exploratory phase)

a. Committee formed to explore the idea in December 2020.

b. Launching initial short course (Análisis Eschatológico) to trial this and gather information regarding viability and interest, to be held in November 2021, and discuss results.

c. Launching further Spanish short courses to explore continued interest.

Blended addition to the Altered programme (completed)

- a. Discussions began in earnest as to the format of the 2022-23 school year in December 2021.
- b. Plan for a blended programme was approved by the school board on January 28, 2022.

Summary:

For Distance Learning Certificate of Theology students, Term 1 will be strictly online in existing Altered format.

In Terms 2 and 3, students will have the option to come onsite for practical ministry experience or they can continue online only. Academics will continue to be the same for those onsite and online.

- d. Sucessfully launched in August 2022, with three students coming on site. Blended option again offered for 2023-2024 school year.

Relanch of Onsite programme (in planning phase)

- a. In December 2022, serious discussion among staff began regarding resuming onsite programme.
- b. School board met to discuss future programmes in January 2023. The decision was made to continue the distance learning programme, and to plan for onsite courses to resume in August 2024.
- c. Re-develop and advertise the onsite programme. FUTURE
- d. Launch onsite programme with return of students and staff in August 2024.
