### *Introduction of Distance Learning Diploma of Theology (completed)*

- a. Need was identified for a Year 2 programme to follow Altered Distance Learning Year 1 in April 2020.

- b. Formation of course plan to include units not included with Altered Year 1.

- c. Finalized with NCFE in May 2021.

- d. Launched in August 2021 with three students enrolled.

- e. After a successful school year, Distance Learning Diploma of Theology certificates presented at Graduation on July 2, 2022.

*Blended addition to the Altered programme (in progress)*

- a. Discussions began in earnest as to the format of the 2022-23 school year in December 2021.
- b. Plan for a blended programme was approved by the school board on January 28, 2022.

Summary:

For Distance Learning Certificate of Theology students, Term 1 will be strictly online in existing Altered format.

In Terms 2 and 3, students will have the option to come onsite for practical ministry experience or they can continue online only. Academics will continue to be the same for those onsite and online.
